



## Campground Rules

1. 5 mph speed limit. Use of vehicles is limited to arriving, parking, and departing.
2. All RVs and vehicles must display an RV Hang Tag. Each person in a vehicle must have a ticket. Going through the entry/exit gate, security will ensure the vehicle has a hang tag and each person has a ticket. No exceptions.
3. Open fires are **not permitted**. Fires in barbecue grills or approved above-ground fire pits are permitted. Fireworks are **prohibited**.
4. All trash should be deposited in trash cans. Do not place trash bags outside of your RV.
5. No washing RVs, when parked next to other RVs in a pod, is allowed. RVs may be washed/detailed if they are removed from the pod group and moved to a clear area in the campground for washing. Removing bugs and cleaning windshields is permitted in the pod area.
6. Vehicles and tow equipment (i.e., tow dollies, etc) may be parked next to the RV pods or near the south fence facing the flea market. Vehicles must be parked outside of the RV pods and not between adjacent RVs.
7. Quiet hours are from 10:00pm to 8:00am. Please be considerate of others.
8. Antennas may be erected or raised from RVs in the parking area, EXCEPT IF PARKED UNDER THE OVERHEAD TRANSMISSION LINES WHICH CROSS THE CAMPGROUND.
9. If waste dumping is needed, the dump station is located just east of the SWAPS building. Follow the main road north and then east near the amphitheater. Do not attempt to drive or tow an RV on the road next to SWAPS. Do not utilize the dump station during show hours.
10. Pets are welcome in the HamCation campground and in outdoor areas, but pets may not be taken inside buildings. Only **Service Animals** as defined under Florida law are permitted inside buildings.
11. Pets must be on a leash and under control of a person at all times. All pets must be up to date on vaccines.
12. Pet owners are required to pick up after their pets and deposit pet waste in appropriate trash cans.
13. Construction is taking place on the fairgrounds. If an unsafe condition is seen (bare wires, sharp objects, etc) report it to the RV staff immediately.
